RESOLUTION NO. M-2602

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE CITY OF OLYMPIA COMMUTE TRIP REDUCTION FOUR-YEAR PLAN UPDATE: 2025-2029

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature passed the Commute Trip Reduction (CTR) Law in 1991 as part of the Washington Clean Air Act and in response to the federal Clean Air Act; and

WHEREAS, the CTR law requires local governments and county governments within affected areas to adopt ordinances that define CTR requirements for affected employers within their jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Olympia City Council adopted the Olympia Commute Trip Reduction Plan (OMC 12.10) on February 2, 1993, and implemented measures as required by the Washington State Commute Trip Reduction Law (RCW 70.94.527); and

WHEREAS, the local CTR plan shall be updated at least once every four years, in order to establish new four-year targets and program strategies and update other elements as needed; and

WHEREAS, the Thurston Regional Planning Council implements the CTR program on behalf of the City of Olympia; and

WHEREAS, the CTR plan aims to decrease the number of drive-alone trips and increase the number of trips made by walking or rolling, biking, and taking transit; and

WHEREAS, the Olympia Comprehensive Plan, the Olympia Transportation Master Plan, and the Thurston Climate Mitigation Plan share goals and targets to reduce vehicle trips;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE that the City of Olympia Commute Trip Reduction Four-Year Plan Update: 2025-2029 is adopted.
