**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON,  
APPROVING AN INCREASE IN CITY STAFFING BY ONE FULL-TIME EQUIVILANT MASTER  
MECHANIC POSITION TO SUPPORT EMERGENCY VEHICLE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE  
AT THE CITY OF OLYMPIA**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Olympia has a program within the Olympia Fire Department for emergency vehicle fleet repair and maintenance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Olympia Fire Department's emergency vehicle fleet repair and maintenance program provides service to several Thurston County customers; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2022 Operating Budget will include additional revenue from two new Mason County customers, as well as existing Thurston County fleet customers, to support the hiring of one additional Master Mechanic full-time equivalent (FTE) position; however, the FTE increase was not identified in the Council's final Operating Budget presentation; and

**WHEREAS**, an additional FTE Master Mechanic position will also support the Olympia Fire Department's on-call emergency vehicle repair and maintenance requirement; and

**WHEREAS**, the overall cost to the City for the additional Master Mechanic position in 2022 will be supported by customer revenue;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** that the increase in City staffing by one full-time equivalent for a Master Mechanic position with funding supported by fleet customer revenue is hereby approved.
