Background:

Olympia Municipal Code 2.100.170 Public Art – Funds for Works of Art spells out the methods for securing funding for the municipal art fund. Specifically, item B states: “All requests for appropriations from the Capital Improvement Project (CIP) budget for construction projects visible and useable by the public, and exceeding five hundred thousand dollars shall include an amount equal to one percent of the estimated construction cost of such project for works of art.

Parks and Public Works developed a process to ensure that funding gets moved into the Art fund in a timely fashion. One half of the anticipated amount is put into the Fund at the beginning of the project. The second half, adjusted per the actual contract amount, is transferred into the fund once bids are opened.

These moneys accumulate over time for use on projects identified by the Arts Commission. There is no requirement that the money be spent on the project that generates the funds.

The 2017 CFP:

The OMC requirement applies to General Fund projects only. Those include;

- General Capital Facilities
- Transportation
- Transportation Projects Funded with Impact Fees
- Parks Projects
