Last year saw the first installment of the Percival Plinth Project: 13 sculptures, loaned by the artists, that graced Percival Landing over the course of one year. One sculpture, **King Salmon** by Dan Klennert, was selected by public vote - the People's Prize - to be purchased by the City of Olympia, and is now permanently located at West Bay Park, 700 West Bay Dr NW.

This year, 15 sculptures have been selected for the year-long exhibition. The public is invited to meet the artists and explore the new exhibition of loaned sculpture on Friday, July 20, 5-7pm, at the Harbor House on Percival Landing, 325 Columbia St NW, Olympia. Voting for this year's People's Prize will begin the following day. The voting period lasts one month and ballots are available along the Percival Landing next to the sculptures. Voters must personally visit all 15 sculptures, and completed ballots must be submitted in person at The Olympia Center, 222 Columbia St NW (conveniently located right next to Percival Landing).
