6.A <u>25-0117</u> Briefing on Middle Housing Phase II

Staff provided an update on the draft ordinance addressing Middle Housing Phase II, methods for public outreach and the anticipated timeline for ordinance review. LUEC gave guidance to staff to ensure flexibility in the code to encourage the development of middle housing.

Staff provided background and regional coordination efforts to develop the model ordinance for disclosure of residential energy performance ratings. LUEC discussed status of the model ordinance and timing with other jurisdictions. LUEC forwarded the proposed model ordinance to City Council for discussion at a Study Session on March 11, 2025.
