<i>New</i>	Commercial recycle/compost haulers register and report	New code	Would require all private companies that haul collect and transport commercial recycling out of Olympia, to include construction and demolition material for recycling, to register for a permit and to report tonnage hauled annually.
<i>New</i>	Reference to Engineering Design and Development Standards Chapter 8	New Code that links solid waste storage design to the EDDS Chapter 8.	Consistent with other utilities
<i>New</i>	Non-Containerized storage of materials inside enclosure prohibited	New code	Addresses the issue of materials such as pallets, furniture, etc., stored in enclosures but prohibited. It is mentioned in the EDDS but the EDDS about planning, design and construction, and not ongoing code enforcement.
<i>New</i>	Waste valet services	New code to prohibit or restrict to certain criteria.	Waste valet services are becoming increasingly popular in multi-family communities, but have implications with sanitary conditions and recycling/composting.
