Key Trends in January-June Data

- 1. Significant rise in use of force incidents
- 2. Sharp decrease in incidents involving juveniles
- 3. 27 (66%) of incidents involved crisis conditions

Ongoing Key Trends

- 1. Body worn cameras greatly enhance transparency
- 2. No evidence of racial bias in OPD use of force
- 3. OPD is consistently cooperative and responsive
