A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, SETTING JULY 11, 2023, AS THE DATE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSAL TO VACATE AS A PUBLIC THOROUGHFARE AN ALLEY NORTH OF 4TH AVENUE BETWEEN ADAMS STREET AND FRANKLIN STREET

WHEREAS, OMC 12.16.050 and RCW 35.79.010 require the City Council to adopt a resolution that sets a public hearing date for the consideration of a right-of-way vacation request; and

WHEREAS, the Olympia City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held regarding the proposal to vacate an alley north of 4th Avenue, between Adams Street and Franklin Street; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of this Resolution is to provide notice to residents and neighbors of the proposed alley vacation and to give the public an opportunity to provide testimony and comment on the vacation petition to Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council, pursuant to OMC 12.016.050 and RCW 35.79.010, hereby initiates the holding of a public hearing on whether to vacate as a public thoroughfare the following legally described property:

THAT PORTION OF BLOCK 33 OF SYLVESTER PLAT AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1, PAGE 14 OF PLATS, RECORDS OF THURSTON COUNTY, WASHINGTON AND BEING A PORTION OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: THAT PORTION OF THE NORTH-SOUTH ALLEY IN SAID BLOCK 33 ADJACENT TO LOTS 6 AND 7 OF SAID BLOCK (BEING APPROXIMATELY 10 FEET WIDE NY 120 FEET LONG).

CONTAINING 1,200 SQUARE FEET, MORE OR LESS;

SITUATE IN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, COUNTY OF THURSTON, STATE OF WASHINTON.

Section 2. July 11, 2023, at 6:00 p.m., or thereafter, as stated upon the City Council's agenda, at the Olympia City Hall Council Chambers, 601 4th Avenue E, Olympia, Washington, is set as the time and place for the public hearing on the proposed alley vacation, such date being not fewer than 20 days nor more than 60 days after the passage of this Resolution.
