

Potential Exit Survey Questions

(Probably no more than 5-7 questions all together)

Motivation and Experience

- How have you enjoyed your committee experience?
- Did you experience the level of engagement you wanted (were they engaged enough with the chair, Council, Liaisons)?
- Why did you agree to serve on this committee?
- Did you receive adequate orientation? Was your role well explained?
- Were there any major surprises? Did things happen as you expected?
- What was most rewarding about your service?
- What did you like least?
- Did you feel you were needed, appreciated, and able to use your skills?

Interactions

- Was it easy to integrate into the committee?
- Did you feel everyone's voice was heard?
- What was your relationship with the chair, staff liaison?
- Were committee meetings productive? Was your time used effectively? If you were Chair, what would you do differently?

Wisdom

- What advice would you offer new committee members?
- What would you do differently now that you have experience serving on the committee?
- How would you improve the way the committee functions?
- What should be the committee's priority right now?

- Would you be interested in remaining active with the City? In what way?
- How would you like to stay involved with the City of Olympia?
