5.B 21-0160 Presentation and Discussion of Olympia's Municipal Criminal Justice System

The presentation was given by Assistant City Manager Debbie Sullivan, Deputy Police Chief Sam Costello, Jail Lieutenant Ren Emerson, Acting Chief Prosecutor Tye Graham, Public Defender Diana Duch, Court Administrator Maryam Olson, Thurston County Public Defense Director Patrick O'Connor, and Thurston County Prosecuting Attorney Jon Tunheim.

The presenters provided an overview on the various components of Olympia's Municipal Criminal Justice System; Police, Prosecution, Public Defense, and Court. Each presenter discussed their area of the justice system including their legal authority;

programs; budget and staffing levels; mission; who they work closely with; areas of discretion in their jobs; efforts taken to reduce inequities, bias, and racial injustice; and opportunities to ensure an equitable and just system. Thurston County staff discussed the County system and shared information on their diversion programs.
