#### 2. BUSINESS ITEM

##### 2.A [16-0236](#) Options for Downtown Public Restrooms

City Manager Steve Hall noted the purpose of the Study Session is for the Council to ask questions and for staff to receive direction on which public restroom options should move forward.

Housing Program Manager Anna Schlecht gave an overview of various discussions that have occurred regarding downtown restrooms. She shared a map of the areas where human waste is found downtown and noted the lack of restrooms creates an undue burden on businesses.

Ms. Schlecht reviewed the goals for expanding public restroom options downtown which include:

- Ensuring restrooms are available for all
- Providing dignified restrooms for street-dependent people
- Engaging community partners in responses
- Reducing negative impact of human waste
- Expanding gender-neutral options
- Developing a shared definition of success

She reviewed the recommendations brought forward from the General Government Committee regarding the issue. The recommendations include immediate, short- mid- and long-term solutions. Ms. Schlecht noted that essential to all the options are performance evaluation tools, funding from Thurston County, and safety monitoring.

General Government Committee members gave background on how they decided on the recommended options. Councilmembers asked clarifying questions.

**Councilmembers agreed to move forward with the immediate option of**

**piloting a human waste clean up crew for the remainder of 2016, as well as the short term option of portable toilets and discussed potential locations.**
