The Committee reviewed each area including: Sleater Kinney/Martin; Pacific/Martin; Downtown; Division/Harrison; Kaiser/Harrison; and the City landfill property. The Committee provided preliminary feedback to the consultant about each of these sites.

The Committee then reviewed the project timeline and examined opportunities for property owners, public, Committee, and City Council involvement. The Committee asked the consultant to reorder the public involvement process to have the outreach to property owners occur prior to the first open house.

The Committee directed staff to place the contract and scope of work on the next available City Council agenda as a Consent Calendar item for consideration by the full Council.
