


## GHG Inventory - Sources of Data

  - Wastewater




#### **Thurston County GHG Emissions**


### **Setting GHG Targets**

- Sustainable Thurston recommended targets
  - 25% reduction from 1990 levels by 2020
  - 45% reduction from 1990 levels by 2035
  - 80% reduction from 1990 levels by 2050
