- OMC Chapter 2.100 Community Member Advisory Boards, Commissions and Committees Appointed by the Olympia City Council is updated
- A new Civilian Police Auditor is selected by the City Council
- Recruitment for the new Community Policing Board is launched

76 Arrests Involved One or More Uses of Force

Types of Force Used	Number
Takedowns (pushes, holds, physical restraint)	65
Controlled holds while hand-cuffing	3
Defensive knee strikes	4
Conducive Energy Weapon (CEW)	7
Lift Subject by arm (act to compel)	1
Drawing service weapon	1
Less lethal munition	1

Key Trends in 2024

1. Significant rise in use of force incidents

2. 56 (74%) of incidents involved crisis conditions

Ongoing Key Trends

- 1. Body worn cameras greatly enhance transparency
- 2. No evidence of racial bias in OPD use of force
- 3. OPD is consistently cooperative and responsive

Misconduct Complaints & Investigations

All 14 Investigations Met Department Standards

Only 1 Sustained Finding of Misconduct
