A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE PACIFIC AVENUE PEDESTRIAN CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT NO. 1547G

**WHEREAS**, the engineer's estimate to complete the Pacific Avenue Pedestrian Crossing Improvement Project No. 1547G was \$211,290.00; and

**WHEREAS**, the lowest responsive and responsible bid submitted on the project was \$330,000.00, which is \$118,710.00 (36%) above the engineer's estimate; and

**WHEREAS**, the City is authorized to reject all bids pursuant to RCW 35.23.352, as well as the City's reservation of rights in its advertisement calling for bids; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff recommends rejection of all bids, allowing staff to re-bid the project later in the year when contractors are more available, which may result in more reasonable bids on the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** The lowest bid received for construction of the Pacific Avenue Pedestrian Crossing Improvement project was \$118,710.00 (36%) above the engineer's estimate; therefore, all bids for the project are rejected pursuant to RCW 35.23.352.
