

Transportation Projects 2009-2012 Multimodal Improvements


Olympia improves the transportation system for people walking, biking and driving.

The types of projects we build are:

- Street resurfacing
- Street reconstruction to add capacity
- Sidewalks
- Bike lanes
- Pedestrian crossing improvements

A range of funding sources is used to complete priority projects. Below is a breakdown of what types of funds were used in this time period.

Funding Sources for Transportation Projects



The City makes an effort to combine improvements into one project for construction and cost efficiencies.

When a street is reconstructed or rebuilt, we look for opportunities to add bike lanes, sidewalks and pedestrian crossing improvements.

A review of what was built from 2009 to 2012 shows:

- Eight street resurfacing projects were completed, all included bicycle and/or pedestrian improvements.
- A total of 4.3 miles of sidewalk were constructed, a total value of \$7.7 million.
- A total of 3.6 miles of bike lanes were added to the bike network.
- Seventeen pedestrian crossing improvements were constructed.
- Grant funds made up nearly a quarter of all funds spent in this time period, nearly as much as City General Fund dollars.
