## PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, the month of June was designated Pride Month to commemorate the Stonewall Riots which occurred in June 1969 and are generally recognized as the catalyst of the LGBTQ+ Rights Movement; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Olympia celebrates the diversity of experiences all residents and visitors have with sexuality, gender, and family; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Olympia commits to making its community a safer and thriving place for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Asexual, and Non-Binary people; and
- WHEREAS, in other states across the country, more than 300 anti-LGBTQ+ bills have been introduced this year with over 130 specifically targeting transgender people, bodily autonomy, and the right to access necessary medical care for trans people; and
- WHEREAS, the Supreme Court is expected to overturn Roe v Wade, which would further erode bodily autonomy and the right to access necessary medical care; and any ruling on Roe v Wade that removes the constitutional right to privacy opens the door to criminalizing acts protected by that right, such as private sexual behavior between consenting adults in their own homes, same-sex marriage, interracial marriage, and access to birth control; and
- WHEREAS, it is now even more essential that local and state governments re-affirm their commitment to supporting LGBTQ+ communities; and
- WHEREAS, 31 years ago Capital City Pride organized the first Washington small town Pride located outside of the relative safety of the big city of Seattle; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Olympia has been honored to serve as the host city for the first Olympia Pride (later renamed Capital City Pride), and every Pride since; and
- WHEREAS, Capital City Pride recognized the City of Olympia with a Key Community Partner award in 2011 as part of the Pride 20th Anniversary recognition; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Olympia is honored to again participate in the Capital City Pride Festival themed "Resilience and Brilliance" to be held June 4, 2022; and

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Olympia City Council does hereby proclaim

## JUNE 2022 as PRIDE MONTH and JUNE 4 & 5 as CAPITAL CITY PRIDE WEEKEND

in the City of Olympia and re-affirms the City's commitment to supporting and protecting LGBTQ+ communities.
