**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON,
REGARDING PETTY CASH AND CHANGE FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the Olympia City Council adopted Resolution No. M-1784 on September 18, 2012, establishing petty cash and change funds; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Auditor has recommended that the Council authorize each individual petty cash and change account and any changes thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Resolution M-1784 is repealed.
