PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, bicycling is one of the cleanest and most energy-efficient forms of transportation; and

WHEREAS, bicycling instead of driving can help us reach greenhouse gas emission reduction targets identified in the Thurston Climate Mitigation Plan; and

WHEREAS, bicycling can help reduce traffic congestion and air and water pollution; and

WHEREAS, bicycling is a mode of transportation well suited to small cities like Olympia, where many of our trips are short; and

WHEREAS, riding a bicycle can improve physical and mental health; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia has an extensive bicycle network which includes a Bike Corridor, 32 miles of bicycle lanes, and 10 miles of the regional trail system within City limits, and

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia adopted its Transportation Master Plan, which includes projects to expand the bicycle network; and

WHEREAS, Intercity Transit, with many sponsors including local businesses and organizations, is hosting the 35th Annual Bicycle Community Challenge during the month of May 2022.

WHEREAS, the Bicycle Community Challenge will count all bicycling miles this year, including miles for exercise and recreation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in recognition of the 52nd Earth Day and the 65th National Bike Month, the Olympia City Council hereby proclaims the month of May 2022 as

"OLYMPIA BICYCLE MONTH"

in the City of Olympia and encourages all citizens to ride their bikes, whether for transportation or recreation, during the month of May and throughout the year.
