

Ordinance No.

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON,
RELATING TO THE 2016 BUDGET, APPROPRIATING WITHIN THE
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND \$203,200 FOR THE QUINCE STREET
SIDEWALK PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, the City has received a Safe Routes to School Grant in the amount of \$203,200;
and

WHEREAS, the City has within its current budget \$50,800 as a match to the grant to fund the
total cost of the project, which is \$254,000; and

WHEREAS, the City must specifically provide for the appropriation of the grant funds into the
project budget; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following appropriations are hereby made:

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance or application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall be unaffected.

Section 3. Ratification. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this Ordinance is hereby ratified and affirmed.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after publication, as provided by law.
