A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, APPROVING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND CATHOLIC COMMUNITY SERVICES OF WESTERN WASHINGTON FOR HOPE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, due to an unpresented rise in unsheltered homelessness in the City of Olympia in 2019, Westminster Presbyterian Church (in partnership with the City of Olympia) opened a tiny house village on church property for persons experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the local, state, and national housing cost and other factors that have led to rises in unsheltered homelessness have not abated; and

WHEREAS, at the Hope Village site, participants are provided basic sanitation, safety, and access to social services; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to contract with a service provider to take over case management duties at the Hope Village site and provide services and amenities to homeless individuals participating in the site; and

WHEREAS, Catholic Community Services has demonstrated in other projects and at other cities to have the skills, resources, and experience to contract with the City to administer the Hope Village site and is willing to do so;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The Olympia City Council hereby approves the form of Professional Services Agreement between the City of Olympia and Catholic Community Services for the Hope Village site and case management, and the terms and conditions contained therein.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Olympia the Agreement, and any other documents reasonably necessary to execute said Agreement, and to make any minor modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the Agreement, or to correct any scrivener's errors.
