## Operation Deep Clean

We are about to launch into a massive, 8-week cleaning effort in the Downtown core. Beginning Aug 28<sup>th</sup>, the Clean Team will be taking on one block face each weekday for deep cleaning.

- Everyday, the Clean Team begins their shift by doing a litter-run through the zone to ensure core cleanliness and to identify any emergent needs.
- Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday they will begin their shift at 6am in order to begin pressure washing earlier in the day, before Downtown “wakes up.” Saturday and Sunday, they will start at 8am, as usual.
