A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT 3 FOR JOINT TRAINING SERVICES AND USE OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA MARK NOBLE REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER

**WHEREAS**, RCW 39.34.010 permits local governmental units to make the most efficient use of their powers by enabling them to cooperate with other localities on a basis of mutual advantage and thereby to provide services and facilities in a manner and pursuant to forms of governmental organization that will accord best with geographic, economic, population and other factors influencing the needs and development of local communities; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to RCW 39.34.080, each party is authorized to contract with any one or more other public agencies to perform any governmental service, activity, or undertaking which each public agency entering into the contract is authorized by law to perform: provided, that such contract shall be authorized by the governing body of each party to the contract and shall set forth its purposes, powers, rights, objectives and responsibilities of the contracting parties;

**WHEREAS**, on November 17, 2016, the City and Fire Protection District 3 (the District) entered into an Interlocal Agreement for Joint Training Services and Use of the City of Olympia Mark Noble Regional Training Center; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 18, 2019, pursuant to the Agreement, the City and the District approved an amendment to Appendix A of the Interlocal Agreement related to personnel hours; and

**WHEREAS**, the parties desire to amend the Interlocal Agreement to allow greater flexibility in the dates that the Fire Chiefs have to amend Appendix A, as well as to make additional edits to reflect current operations;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Olympia City Council hereby approves the form of Amendment No. 2 to the Interlocal Agreement between the City of Olympia and Fire Protection District 3 for Joint Training services and use of the Mark Noble Regional Training Center and the terms and conditions contained therein.
