A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR THE QUINCE STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT NO. 1605G.

WHEREAS, the low bid on the Quince Street Sidewalk Project No. 1605G was determined to be not responsible; and

WHEREAS, the lowest responsive and responsible bid submitted on the project was \$337,140, which is \$45,335 (16%) above the engineer's estimate of \$291,805; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to reject all bids pursuant to RCW 35.23.352, as well as the City's reservation of rights in its advertisement calling for bids; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends rejection of all bids, allowing staff to re-bid the project later in the year when contractors are more available, which may result in more reasonable bids on the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE that the lowest bid received for construction of the Quince Street Sidewalk project was \$45,335 (16%) above the engineer's estimate; therefore, all bids for the project are rejected pursuant to RCW 35.23.352.
