2. Approve Agenda (6:17 - 6:19)

Michelle asked that the discussion on bike corridors be first on the agenda.

5a. 14-0191 Subcommittee on Bike Parking Code Compliance

Michelle shared that Tom Hill sent her some development plans to look at for bicycle parking. She is recommending a couple of committee members meet with Community Planning and Development staff to review the plans and gain a better understanding of how the review process works.

Clark, Anne and Christina all offered to be on the sub-committee. Clark asked Michelle to put this out to the committee members who were not at the meeting.

5b. 14-0192 Comprehensive Plan Update

Sophie provided an update from the February 25 Council meeting. The Planning Commission draft is the version of the Comp Plan Update that is now before Council for their review. There will be a new draft published before Council's Public Hearing, and that is what Council is looking for BPAC to comment on.

5c. 14-0193 Bike Corridor Routes

Michelle gave a presentation on bike corridors and reminded the committee that Council approved \$100,000 for a pilot in 2014. Her presentation included some options for bicycle corridors throughout Olympia. She distributed maps of those proposed options and asked the committee to ride the routes and be prepared to provide comments and suggestions.
