

POTENTIAL ORDINANCE CHANGES FOR CONSIDERATION
RELATING TO THE DOWNTOWN PROJECT

- Repeal Ordinances relating to Busking so that Busking activities will be unrestricted
 - OMC Chapter 5.88
 - OMC 9.16.180(B)(3)(IX) & OMC 9.16.180(B)(8)
- Increase “Pedestrian Walking Lane” to include entire width of sidewalks downtown
 - OMC 9.16.180.B.2
- Change sidewalk use rules and hours of application
 - Currently 7am to 10pm
 - Change to 7am to 12am
- Change process for enforcement to ensure that the first step is education and the second step is asking for compliance by adding a requirement of a warning prior to citation for violation of regulations concerning use of City owned property and sidewalks.
- Expand restrictions on camping and building camping structures to all City owned property and to public spaces that are designated as parklets.
- Provide clear definition of what constitutes camping and building camping structures.
- Provide allowance for permitted camping on City property for specific purposes, such as special events and temporary uses and other permitted activities.
