

RESOLUTION NO. M-2709

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A WATER QUALITY COMBINED FINANCIAL GRANT AGREEMENT WITH THE WASHINGTON STATE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY FOR THE GREEN STORMWATER RETROFIT AT ROGER AND HAYS PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$893,200

WHEREAS, The City of Olympia's Stormwater Utility has been selected to receive grant total funding for constructing the Green Stormwater Retrofit at Roger and Hays project through a Water Quality Combined Financial Assistance Grant offered by the Department of Ecology. The project will install bioretention facilities in the vicinity of Rogers and Hays streets to provide treatment for total suspended solids (TSS), dissolved copper, and dissolved zinc and to reduce flows to Budd Inlet by increasing stormwater infiltration; and


WHEREAS, the grant funding from the Department of Ecology in the amount of \$759,220, with a 15 percent match required (\$133,980) for a total cumulative project cost of \$893,200, will be deposited into the Storm and Surface Water CIP Fund 434; and

WHEREAS, per Olympia Municipal Code Section 3.16.020.C, it is necessary for the City Council to approve the Grant Agreement and authorize the signature of all documents necessary to receive the funds;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:


1. The Olympia City Council hereby approves the attached Water Quality Combined Grant Financial Grant Agreement between the Washington State Department of Ecology and the City of Olympia for the Green Stormwater Retrofit at Rogers and Hays project and the terms and conditions contained in the Agreement.
2. The City Manager is directed and authorized to execute the attached Water Quality Combined Financial Grant Agreement on behalf of the City of Olympia, and to make any minor modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the Agreement, and to correct any scrivener's errors.
