WHEREAS, bicycling can connect many community members to opportunities and resources without needing to own or maintain a car; and

WHEREAS, riding a bicycle can improve physical and mental health; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia has a bicycle network which includes a Bike Corridor, 32 miles of bicycle lanes, and 10 miles of the regional trail system within City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City's Transportation Master Plan includes projects to expand the bicycle network; and

WHEREAS, the City's Street Safety Plan prioritizes the safety of bicyclists, among other vulnerable users of the street; and

WHEREAS, Intercity Transit, with the support of many local businesses and organizations, is hosting the 36th Annual Bicycle Community Challenge during the month of May 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in recognition of the 53rd Earth Day and the 66th National Bike Month, the Olympia City Council hereby proclaims the month of May 2023 as

in the City of Olympia and encourages all citizens to ride their bikes during the month of May and throughout the year.
