## SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AGREEMENT (Annexation Transition RCW 35A.14.900)

This SOLID WASTE COLLECTION AGREEMENT ("Agreement") is made and entered into between HAROLD LEMAY ENTERPRISES, INCORPORATED ("LeMay") and the CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON ("City"). The parties shall be collectively referred to herein as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party", unless specifically identified otherwise. This Agreement shall be effective upon the date that both Parties have executed this Agreement (the "Effective Date"), as evidenced by the signatures below. The Parties agree as follows.

## RECITALS

WHEREAS by Ordinance Nos. 6897, 6876, 6488, 6433, 6431, 6352, 6396, 6423, 6432, 6438, and 6477 (the "Ordinances") and attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>, the City has annexed certain territory identified in the Ordinances;

WHEREAS LeMay holds Certificate No. G-98, issued by the WUTC for the collection, transportation and disposal of solid waste in certain areas in Washington State, including within Thurston County and in the Annexed Territory;

**WHEREAS** under RCW 35A.14.900, the WUTC regulates the collection of solid waste within the Annexed Territory until such time as the City notifies the WUTC, in writing, of its decision to contract for solid waste collection or provides solid waste collection itself pursuant to RCW 81.77.020;

WHEREAS the City has given notice under RCW 35A.14.900 that it intends to undertake the collection of municipal solid waste ("MSW"), as defined in WAC 173-350-100, from residents and businesses within the Annexed Territory, and is therefore required by RCW 35A.14.900 to grant to LeMay a franchise for the collection of MSW in the Annexed Territory for a term of not less than SEVEN (7) years;

WHEREAS in addition to the requirement to grant to LeMay a 7-year franchise for the collection of MSW in the Annexed Territory, RCW 35A.14.900 and case law also grant to LeMay a right of action to recover any measurable damages resulting from the City's decision to contract for MSW collection or provide MSW collection itself;

WHEREAS the City and LeMay agree to satisfy the requirements of RCW 35A.14.900, including the requirement to grant a seven-year franchise and the waiver of any claims for measurable damages, by entering into this Agreement to grant to LeMay the exclusive right to collect MSW from residential, commercial and industrial customers within the Annexed Territory during the Transition Period (as defined herein);

**WHEREAS** the Parties wish to enter into this Agreement setting forth the terms and conditions governing LeMay collection within the Annexed Territory during the Transition Period;

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Transition Period and Commencement of Service. For any annexations occurring after December 31, 2013, the Parties agree that the "Transition Period" shall commence on the effective date of the individual annexation and shall continue for a period of ten years, unless both parties agree to a different time interval. The City of Olympia City Council authorizes the City Manager to also agree, on behalf of the City, to a shorter time frame. Concerning Ordinance Nos. 6897, 6876, 6488, 6433, and 6431, the transition period shall be ten years from the effective date of the individual annexation ordinances. For all other annexation ordinances issued prior to the effective date of this agreement (Ordinance Nos. 6352, 6396, 6423, 6432, 6438 and 6477), the transition period shall be seven years from the effective date of the Ordinance. So that customer service shall not be disrupted, service by the City shall commence only upon sixty or more days' notice to LeMay and shall begin on the first day of the calendar month following notice after expiration of the transition period.

2. Grant of Exclusive Franchise. The City hereby grants to LeMay the exclusive right and obligation to collect MSW from residential and commercial customers within the Annexed Territory during the Transition Period (hereinafter the "Collection Services"). During the Transition Period, the City agrees that, it shall not contract for Collection Services or itself provide Collection Services within the Annexed Territory. As a result of the grant of this franchise, which as noted, is longer than the minimum term set forth in RCW 35A.14.900, LeMay hereby waives any rights it may have to seek measurable damages due to the annexation terminating its regulated solid waste services and cancelling a portion of its certificate authority.

**3.** Rates and Compensation. LeMay shall be compensated for the Collection Services hereunder by charging its residential, commercial and industrial customers within the Annexed Territory the same rates and charges authorized under the tariffs approved by the WUTC for LeMay customers located within LeMay's Certificate G-98 service territory in Thurston County, (the "WUTC Tariffs").

4. Notification of Taxes, Fees, and Other Charges. If, as a result of the City's annexation of the Annexed Territory, the City imposes any taxes, fees, or charges on LeMay Collection Services within the Annexed Territory, the City shall notify LeMay a minimum of FORTY-FIVE (45) days before the taking effect of such taxes, fees, or other charges subject to WUTC approval (where applicable) of any such taxes, fees or charges.

**5.** Revisions to WUTC Tariffs. Nothing in this Agreement is intended to restrict or prohibit LeMay from seeking approval from the WUTC for new and/or revised WUTC Tariffs applicable to MSW collection within Certificate No. G-98's territory in Thurston County. In the event that the WUTC approves revisions to LeMay WUTC Tariffs, LeMay shall similarly adjust the rates and charges applicable to the Collection Services within the Annexed Territory.

6. Additional Services. If the City elects to offer additional solid waste collection services to residential and commercial customers within the Annexed Territory, the City shall notify LeMay in writing of the additional services requested, and LeMay shall have the right to provide such additional services during the Transition Period. If LeMay elects to provide such additional services, LeMay shall notify the City in writing within THIRTY (30) days of receipt of the City's notice and shall offer such services consistent with the rates providing for such under its WUTC tariffs.

7. Billing. LeMay shall be responsible for billing its residential, commercial and industrial customers within the Annexed Territory for the Collection Services. LeMay shall invoice its customers generally consistent with the WUTC procedures in WAC 480-70-396 through WAC 480-70-416.

**8.** Delinquent Accounts and Refusal of Service. LeMay shall have and retain all rights authorized by law to collect delinquent accounts (as defined in WAC 480-70-396), including, but not limited to, the right to cancel Collection Services for any of the reasons under WAC 480-70-376(1). LeMay shall have and retain all rights authorized by law to refuse or cancel service to a customer, including the right to refuse or cancel service for any reason under WAC 480-70-368(2).

**9.** Collection Service Requirements. Except as otherwise stated herein or unless inconsistent with any provision herein, LeMay shall provide the Collection Services consistent with the requirements of Chapter 480-70 WAC and its WUTC Tariffs.

**10. Transition of LeMay Collection Services to City**. After the end of the Transition Period:

10.1. the City shall assume full responsibility for MSW collection within the Annexed Territory as authorized under RCW 81.77.020, by providing MSW collection itself;

10.2. unless otherwise agreed to in writing by the Parties, LeMay shall have no further obligation under this Agreement to provide the Collection Services within the Annexed Territory;

10.3. LeMay acknowledges that by entering into this franchise, it intends to waive all claims under RCW 35.13.280, including those for measurable damages which waiver shall be fully effective immediately after the expiration of the transition period; and

10.4. LeMay and the City agree to cooperate with each other so that solid waste collection service is not disrupted. This cooperation shall include the sharing of customer information in a reasonably prompt manner prior to the City's assumption of service.

Upon request of the City, the Parties shall meet prior to the end of the Transition Period to plan for the transition of the Collection Services within the Annexed Territory. LeMay shall cooperate with the City by providing all reasonably necessary information required by the City to allow for an orderly transition of the Collection Services from LeMay to the City.

**11. Required Notices to WUTC.** The City shall be responsible for submitting any and all notices to the WUTC of its decision to annex an area pursuant to RCW 81.77.020 and ultimately commence services as described in Section 1, above.

**12. Cooperation in Execution of Documents.** The Parties agree to cooperate in preparing, executing, and delivering any and all additional documents that may be necessary to render this Agreement legally and practically effective, provided, however, that this provision shall not require the execution of any document that expands, alters or in any way changes the terms of this Agreement.

**13.** Force Majeure. If any Party is prevented from or delayed in performing its duties under this Agreement by circumstances beyond its control, whether or not foreseeable, including, without limitation, fires, typhoons, hurricanes, severe weather, floods, volcanic eruptions, pandemics, quarantines, war, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, labor disputes, acts of God, or threats of such circumstances, or any future laws, rules, regulations, orders, or acts of any local, state, federal, or provincial government ("Force Majeure"), then the affected Party shall be excused from performance hereunder during the period of such disability. The Party claiming Force Majeure shall promptly notify the other Party when it learns of the existence of a Force Majeure condition and when the Force Majeure condition has terminated.

14. Successors and Assigns. No Party shall assign this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party, except that LeMay may assign this Agreement to any subsidiary, parent, sister or affiliated company without the other Party's consent. If this Agreement is assigned as provided above, it shall be binding on and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.

**15.** Notice. Any notice required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing (including, without limitation, by facsimile transmission) and sent to the address shown below:

16. Entire Agreement; Amendment. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement among the Parties concerning the subject matter hereof and supersedes all previous correspondence, communications, agreements and understandings, whether oral or written among the Parties. This Agreement may not be modified, in whole or in part, except upon unanimous approval of the Parties and by a writing signed by all the Parties.

17. Advice of Counsel/Full Understanding. This Agreement was negotiated at armslength with each Party receiving advice from independent legal counsel. It is the intent of the Parties that no part of this Agreement be construed against either of the Parties because of the identity of the drafter. Moreover, the parties each acknowledge, represent and agree that they have read this Agreement; that they fully understand the terms thereof; that they have been fully advised by their independent legal counsel, accountants and other advisors with respect thereto.

**18.** No Third Party Beneficiaries. This Agreement is made solely and specifically among and for the benefit of the parties hereto, and their respective successors and assigns, and

no other person will have any rights, interest, or claim hereunder or be entitled to any benefits under or on account of this Agreement, whether as a third party beneficiary or otherwise.

**19. Construction**. In case any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, that invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision in this Agreement and this Agreement shall be construed as if the invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained in it.

**20.** Alternative Dispute Resolution/Legal Fees. Any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, including any question regarding breach, termination or invalidity thereof shall be resolved by mediation or arbitration in Seattle or Olympia, Washington in accordance with the American Arbitration Association or Judicial Dispute Resolution rules which are deemed to be incorporated by reference in this clause. The maximum number of arbitrators shall be one in any claim, suit, action or other proceeding relating in any way to this Agreement or any claims arising out of this Agreement, except as otherwise ordered or agreed to by the parties. Other than mediation costs, in the event any arbitration or legal action is taken by either party against the other to enforce any of the terms and conditions of this Agreement, it is agreed that the unsuccessful party of such action shall pay to the prevailing party therein all court costs, reasonable attorney's fees and expenses incurred by the prevailing party.

**21.** Governing Law. This Agreement, and all amendments or supplements thereto, shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.

**22.** Counterparts. This Agreement may be executed in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.

**23.** Authority. The Parties each represent and warrant that they have full power and actual authority to enter into this Agreement and to carry out all actions required of them by this Agreement. All persons executing this Agreement in representative capacities represent and warrant that they have full power and authority to bind their respective corporation.

**24.** No Admission of Liability. This Agreement does not constitute and shall not be construed as an admission of liability, fault or responsibility on the part of any of the Parties.

**25. Binding Effect; Assignability**. This Agreement shall bind and inure to the benefit of the Parties hereto and their respective officers, employees and agents, heirs, legatees, representatives, receivers, trustees, successors, transferees and assigns.

**26.** Severability. If any provision of this Agreement is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or in violation of any statute, rule, regulation or common law such provision shall be considered null and void, with the remaining provisions remaining viable and in effect. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Parties acknowledge and agree that this Agreement, and the releases provided for above, are each necessary to this Agreement; without any of these, the Parties would not enter this Agreement.

**27. Headings Not Controlling**. The paragraph headings included herein are for reference only and are not parts of this Agreement. The headings shall not control or alter the meaning of this Agreement as set forth in the text.

**28. Equal Participation in Drafting**. The Parties have participated and had an equal opportunity to participate in the drafting of this Agreement. No ambiguity shall be construed against any party based upon a claim that that party drafted the ambiguous language.

**29.** Waiver. Any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement may be waived, but only by a written notice signed by the Party waiving such terms or conditions. A waiver or any breach of, or failure to enforce, any of the terms or conditions of this Agreement shall not in any way affect, limit or waive a party's rights to enforce compliance thereafter with each and every term and condition of this Agreement.

**30.** Agreement Not Legal Precedent. The Parties acknowledge and agree that this Agreement is not intended to constitute legal precedent in any future dispute or litigation regarding any unrelated matter involving the Parties or any other municipality, government entity or third party related to any damages that may result from the annexation of territories for which a solid waste collection company has previously been granted operating authority by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

**IN WITNESS WHEREOF**, the Parties enter into this Agreement. Each person signing this Agreement represents and warrants that he or she has been duly authorized to enter into this Agreement by the Party on whose behalf it is indicated that the person is signing.-

#### Ordinance No. 6897

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF OLYMPIA APPROXIMATELY 205 ACRES LYING CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND WITHIN THE OLYMPIA URBAN GROWTH AREA, REFERRED TO AS THE "BOULEVARD/I-5 ANNEXATION," SITUATED IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 24, THE EAST HALF OF THE SOUTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 2 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, THE SOUTH HALF OF SECTION 18, THE NORTH HALF OF SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 1 WEST, WILLAMETTE MERIDIAN, THURSTON COUNTY, WASHINGTON.

WHEREAS, during 2009, the Washington State Legislature passed ESSB 5808, amending RCW 35A.14, allowing code cities to annex territory served by one or more fire districts; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.14.480 authorizes code citles to accomplish the annexation by ordinance after entering into an interlocal agreement with the affected fire district(s) and County; and

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2010, the City of Olympia did, according to the requirements under RCW 35A.14.480, notify Lacey Fire District Three and Thurston County of its desire to enter into an interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, on February 18, 2014, the Thurston County Board of Commissioners approved the interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, on February 20, 2014, Lacey Fire District Three approved the Interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2014, the Olympia City Council approved the interlocal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation is situated in a "County island" that is entirely surrounded by the City of Olympia; and

WHEREAS, both emergency police and fire protection services are already currently provided by the City of Olympia through mutual aid agreements with Lacey Fire District Three and Thurston County; and

WHEREAS, Goal UGM2 of the City of Olympia/Thurston County Joint Plan supports annexation of unincorporated Islands within City limits; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Olympia hosted public informational meetings on December 18, 2013, and March 10, 2014, to inform all residents and property owners of the area of this proposal and to provide information regarding the annexation; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2014, the Olympia City Council determined that the annexation of the hereinafter described property to the City of Olympia would be in the public interest and for the public welfare and in the best interest of the City of Olympia and the citizens thereof;

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** <u>Annexation</u>. The property described and depicted in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein as If fully set forth, is hereby annexed to the City of Olympia.

Section 2. <u>Existing Indebtedness</u>. It is hereby further declared that upon annexation, the property described in Section 1 above shall be subject to existing indebtedness of the City of Olympia.

**Section 3.** <u>Solid Waste Collection</u>. Pursuant to RCW 35A.14.900, on the effective date of this Ordinance any franchise or permit theretofore granted to any person, firm or corporation by the State of Washington, or by the governing body of such annexed territory, authorizing or otherwise permitting the operation or any public utility, including but not limited to, public water, transportation, garbage disposal, or other similar public service business or facility within the limits of the annexed territory is cancelled. The holder of any such franchise permit canceled pursuant to this section and RCW 35A.14.900 is hereby granted a franchise to continue such business within the annexed territory for a term of not less than seven (7) years from the date of this Ordinance. The City shall not extend similar or competing services to the annexed territory except upon a proper showing of the inability or refusal of such person, firm or corporation to adequately service said annexed territory at a reasonable price. This section may be superseded by subsequent mutual agreement of the City of Olympia and a franchise holder.

**Section 4.** <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall be in effect at the end of the day (midnight) June 20, 2014.

**Section 5.** <u>Development Applications</u>. Between the adoption and the effective date of this Ordinance, if requested by Thurston County, the City of Olympia will assume responsibility for reviewing development applications in the County island and would thus be entitled to the applicable permit review fees.

**Section 6.** <u>Severability</u>. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared separate and severable. If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance or application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall be unaffected.

**Section 7.** <u>Ratification</u>. Any act consistent with the authority and prior to the effective date of this Ordinance is hereby ratified and affirmed.

Thence North along the East line of said DLC No. 42 and extension thereof to the South Right-of-Way of Interstate 5;

Thence tracing along said South Right-of-Way of Interstate 5 to the POINT OF BEGINNING.
