**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON,
APPROVING A LEASE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND INTERCITY
TRANSIT FOR A PORTION OF THE TRANSIT CENTER LOCATED AT 222 STATE AVENUE, IN
OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON**

WHEREAS, Intercity Transit and the City of Olympia have discussed the lease of certain premises from City Transit for use as space by the Olympia Police Department for crisis response services, and uses reasonably compatible and related to such law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to memorialize the terms and conditions of the lease of Intercity Transit's premises in this Lease Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Crisis response services fulfills a valuable community need and locating services at the Transit Center will be beneficial for the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Olympia City Council hereby agrees to and approves the terms and conditions of the 2022 Lease Agreement with Intercity Transit for a portion of Transit Center located at 222 State Avenue in Olympia, WA.
2. The City Manager is directed and authorized to execute the Lease Agreement with Intercity Transit. The City Manager is also authorized to modify any terms consistent with the intent of the Lease, and to correct any scrivener's errors in said Lease Agreement, as may be required.
