Do Not Amend the City's Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map and its zoning map to redesignate the Trillium property, leaving it designated Neighborhood Village

MOTION: "I move to leave the City's Comprehensive Plan Future Land Use map and its Official Zoning Map unchanged, with the Trillium property remaining Neighborhood Village."

FINDINGS OF FACT - COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AMENDMENT (SECTION 18.59.040 OMC):

- 1. The existing Neighborhood Village comprehensive plan designation and zoning is appropriate for the site, and consistent with designations in the vicinity, especially the Bentridge property.
- 2. The applicant has not established that the proposed amendment / rezone are necessary, or that they would produce results that are more consistent with Comprehensive Plan goals than is possible under the current designation and zoning.
- 3. The proposed designations and zones are less supportive of eventual transit service, and less supportive of the goials of the Washington State Growth Management Act.
