# Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus

## CDBG-CV2

- City applied for funding from Department of Commerce in 2021
- City received \$93,036 in federal CDBG-CV2 funding for preparation, prevention and response to Coronavirus



# Activities

CDBG-CV2 funding support the Homeless Response Coordinator in 2021 and 2022

Homeless Response Coordinator provided outreach and services for Olympians experiencing homelessness



# Additional Funding

The City applied for additional funding in 2023 and received \$48,222, bringing the total CDBG-CV2 award to \$141,258.



# Additional Funding Activities

The City awarded subrecipient OlyMAP \$20,000 to provide case management, site support, safety and survival supplies for 11 residents of the New Hope Tiny Home Village and 28 former residents of the Nickerson camp community.



# **Additional Funding Activities cont'd**

\$20,000 of CDBG-CV2 funding was used for the Homeless Response Team. The Homeless Response Team provided cold weather supplies and survival gear to unhoused Olympians.
