A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, FIXING MAY 24, 2022, AS THE DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING ON A PROPOSAL TO VACATE AS A PUBLIC THOROUGHFARE A PORTION OF ROSE STREET

WHEREAS, OMC 12.16.050 and RCW 35.79.010 require the City Council to adopt a resolution which sets a public hearing date for the consideration of a petition to vacation right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Olympia City Council has determined that a public hearing should be held regarding the proposal to vacate a portion of Rose Street; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of this Resolution is to provide notice to residents and neighbors of the proposed street vacation and to give the public an opportunity to provide testimony and comment on the vacation petition to Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council, pursuant to OMC 12.16.050 and RCW 35.79.010, hereby initiates procedures hold a public hearing whether to vacate as a public thoroughfare the following legally described property:

THAT PORTION OF ROSE STREET LYING NORTH OF THE NORTH MARGIN OF PINE AVENUE AND LYING 60-FEET EAST OF THE EAST BOUNDARY OF BLOCK 64 HALE ADDITION TO OLYMPIA.

Containing 4,200 square feet, more or less. (Approximately 70' x 60')

Section 2. May 24, 2022, at the hour of 7:00 p.m. or thereafter, as stated on the City Councils agenda, at the Olympia City Hall Council Chambers, 601 4th Avenue E, Olympia, Washington, is fixed as the time and place for the public hearing on said proposed street vacation, such time shall not be more than 60 days nor less than 20 days after the passage of this Resolution.
