A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, APPROVING A LOAN AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY FOR REPLACEMENT OF A WASTEWATER LIFT STATION

WHEREAS, the Department of Ecology administers federal Clean Water Act National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) municipal wastewater permits in Washington State; and

WHEREAS, the NPDES permit issued to the LOTT Alliance covers the wastewater collection systems managed by the City of Olympia; and

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia wastewater utility maintains, rehabilitates, and replaces elements of the wastewater collection system to provide municipal services to residents, and to protect the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Old Port 1 lift station has reached the end of its useful design life, and the current station is at risk from both landslide and sea level rise; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater utility intends to replace the existing infrastructure with a new, more resilient system; and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Department of Ecology has awarded the City of Olympia a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan in the amount of \$3,229,920.00 with a 30-year term at 1.6% interest (Agreement No. WQC-2024-Olympi-00212) to finance the replacement of the Old Port 1 lift station; and

WHEREAS, accepting the State Revolving Fund loan will allow the wastewater utility to proceed with the project and minimize ratepayer impacts associated with the construction;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:
