Kaiser-Harrison 'Opportunity Area' Plan

In 2013, the City's consultant, ECONorthwest, completed a report, *Investment Strategy:* City of Olympia Opportunity Areas. The study analyzed five Opportunity Areas in the city outside of the downtown, and recommended actions the City could take to facilitate redevelopment of these areas.

For the Kaiser/Harrison Area (see map on the other side of this page), the Olympia Comprehensive Plan envisions a mix of medical services, retail and housing. The existing zoning segregates these uses in separate portions of this area. The *Investment Strategy* recommends re-examining these zoning issues as part of a broader planning process for this area.

The City is now conducting this planning process for the Kaiser-Harrison Area.*
