#### **6.A** <u>16-1342</u> 2017 Budget Update

City Engineer Fran Eide provided an update on the Capital Facilities Plan and shared information on projects projected to meet or exceed \$500,000 in construction costs, that would trigger the 1% for Art ordinance. Her briefing paper is attached.

Associate Parks Director Jonathon Turlove similarly provided insight into upcoming parks projects, including the proposed Woodruff Sprayground and Grass Lake Nature Park improvements. He also shared that for the upcoming West Bay Park and Habitat Master Plan, the Request for Qualifications will specify that an artist is part of the design team.

## **6.B** <u>16-1344</u> Meet Amy Solomon-Minarchi

Commissioners provided a warm welcome to Amy Solomon-Minarchi, Olympia's first Poet Laureate. Ms. Solomon-Minarchi shared some of the program ideas she has been considering as she develops her scope of work with the City. When queried on the recruitment process, the poet noted that the opportunity came across as serious, straightforward and fair. As the first Poet Laureate, Ms. Solomon-Minarchi noted there is added opportunity/responsibility to set the tone.

#### 6.C 16-1343 Arts Walk Cover Artists 2017

Ms. Johnson shared the recommendation of the jury for Spring (Loralin Toney) and Fall (Evan Clayton Horback) Arts Walk covers 2017 and alternates, Cha Davis and Lee McCraw-Leavitt. Commissioner Perry abstained from voting as he was on the jury.

Ms. Johnson shared the review group's recommendation to go with Framework as the Master Plan consultant. Commissioner Nelson noted that Framework was one of the two applicants (of 4) that successfully communicated an understand of the project. Vice Chair Hicks observed that Framework demonstrated more defined roles among team members, addressed technical specifications upfront, and had idenitfied prior experience in smaller communities. Ms. Johnson shared that she would follow up with reference calls and a clarification on frequency of community meetings with Framework before presenting the recommendation to the Parks, Arts & Recreation Director for approval.
