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## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS FOR REPAIR OF A WATERMAIN BREAK ON HARBOR VIEW DRIVE

**WHEREAS**, on June 3, 2022, City staff discovered a watermain break on Harbor View Drive, and determined that failure of the watermain and associated road damage could result in further threats to public safety and property damage; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 39.04.280 defines an emergency as "unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the municipality that either: (a) Present a real, immediate threat to the proper performance of essential functions; or (b) Will likely result in material loss or damage to property, bodily injury, or loss of life if immediate action is not taken;" and

**WHEREAS,** RCW 39.04.280 provides for an exemption from competitive bidding requirements for public works in the event of an emergency and that, "if a contract is awarded without competitive bidding due to an emergency, a written finding of the existence of an emergency must be made by the governing body or its designee and duly entered of record;" and

WHEREAS, pursuant to OMC 3.16.030 and City Policy, authority has been delegated to the City Engineer to declare any public work an emergency so long as it meets the criteria set forth in RCW 39.04.280; and

**WHEREAS,** the City Engineer determined that the situation on Harbor View Drive constituted an emergency as defined in RCW 39.04.280, declared an emergency, and thereafter entered into a contract without calling for bids with Lakeside Industries Inc., for emergency repairs of the road;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Olympia City Council finds, declares, and affirms the actions of the City Engineer in that the repairs along Harbor View Drive constituted an emergency as defined in RCW 39.04.280 because the watermain break and associated road damage presented a real, immediate threat to public safety and property.
