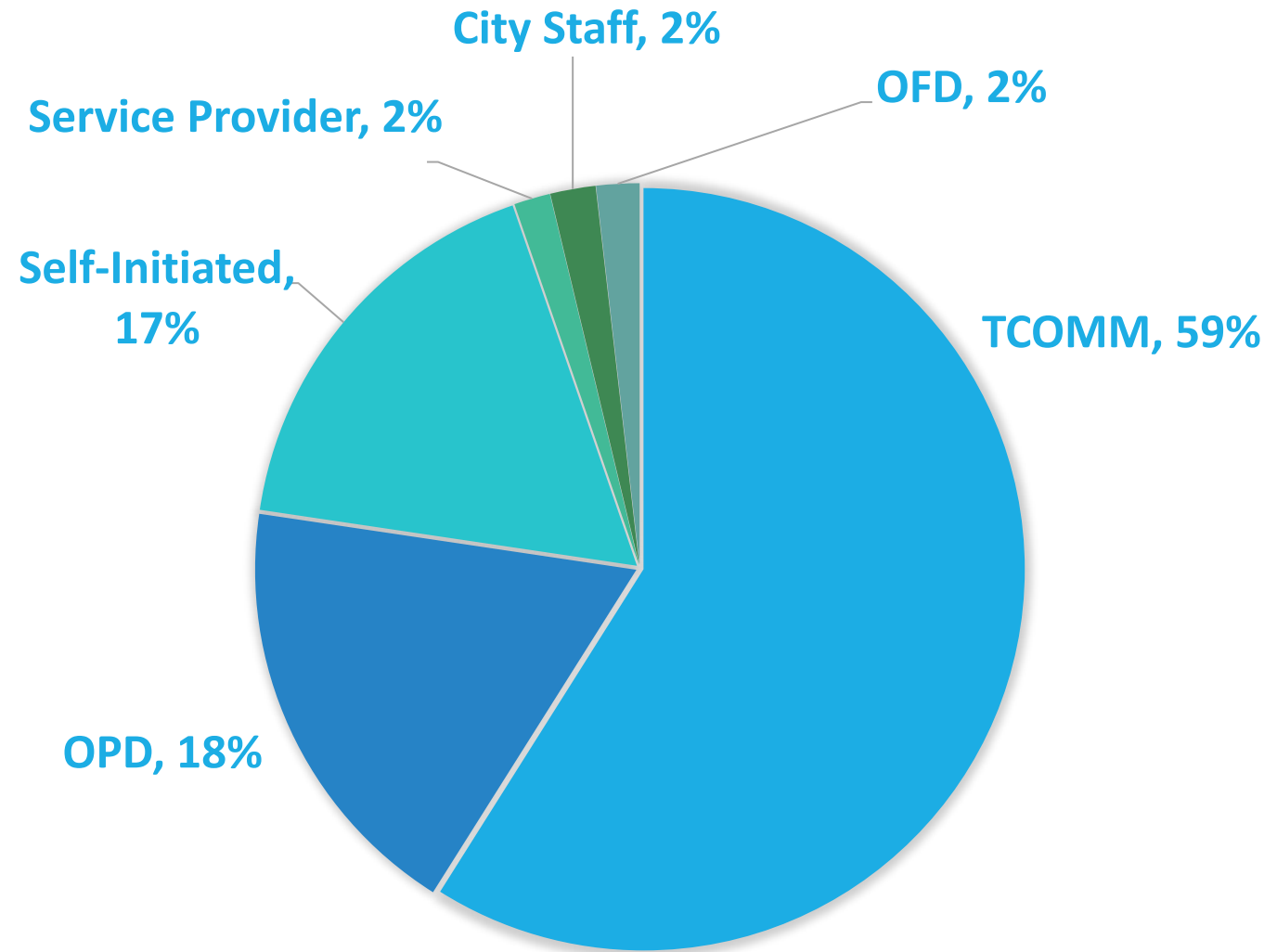

Policy Updates

Based on Auditor Recommendations:

Policy 320 – Standards of Conduct

- The discrimination language found in the Citywide policy was preferred.
- OPD adopted the Citywide policy language.

Policy 1010 – Complaints

- The categories of “Service Level” and “Serious” are outdated language.
- OPD deleted this language.

Based on Policy Team Review:

- 68 policies were updated.
