In presenting the character areas that define different aspects of the downtown, Ms. Buckler observed that it makes sense for a future Creative District to follow the outlines of one or more of the character areas, such as the Entertainment and Artisan/Tech areas. Citing the extensive public process that has shaped the planning, the Commission agreed that these efforts should work together. Ms. Buckler invited Commissioners to attend the Downtown Strategy Urban Design workshop on May 23.
