A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, ACCEPTING WASHINGTON STATE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE SAFETY GRANT FUNDS FOR THE LEGION WAY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Olympia applied for and received Washington State Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant funds (the Grant Funds) in June 2019, for the City's Legion Way Improvements Project (the Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project includes resurfacing Legion Way from Water Street to Franklin Street and includes a raised, concrete intersection at Washington Street; and

WHEREAS, the City must sign and submit to the Washington State Department of Transportation documents to obligate grant funds for a total estimated cost of \$795,680; and

WHEREAS, per Olympia Municipal Code Section 3.16.020(c), it is necessary for the City Council to accept the Washington State Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant funds and authorize the signature of all documents necessary to obligate funds for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

- 1. The Olympia City Council hereby accepts the Washington State Pedestrian and Bicycle Safety grant funds for the amount awarded of \$795,680.
- 2. The City Manager is authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City of Olympia any documents necessary to obligate Washington State Pedestrian and Bicycle grant funds for the Legion Way Improvements Project, and to make any minor modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the agreement, or to correct any scrivener's errors.
