A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, APPROVING A COMPLETE STREETS GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OLYMPIA AND THE WASHINGTON STATE TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT BOARD (TIB) FOR THE SOUTHEAST TO DOWNTOWN BIKE CORRIDOR PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) provides funding to help communities build complete streets that serve all users, whether walking, biking, driving or riding transit; and

WHEREAS, the City applied for and on March 25, 2022, was awarded a TIB Complete Streets Grant in the amount of \$300,000 to assist in funding the Southeast to Downtown Bike Corridor project (Project), which is estimated to have total costs of \$989,000; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified projects, including bicycle corridors, in the *Transportation Master Plan*, that will make it easier for people to bicycle, and the Southeast to Downtown Bike Corridor Project is a priority project; and

WHEREAS, in order to receive the TIB Complete Streets Grant funds for the Project, the City must execute a Grant Agreement with the TIB; and

WHEREAS, per Olympia Municipal Code Subsection 3.16.020.C, it is necessary for the City Council to approve the Grant Agreement and authorize the signature of all documents necessary to obligate funds for the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Olympia City Council hereby approves the Grant Agreement between the City of Olympia and TIB for the Southeast to Downtown Bike Corridor Project and the terms and conditions contained therein.
2. The City Manager is directed and authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Olympia the Grant Agreement, and any other documents necessary to obligate funds for the Project, and to make any amendments or minor modifications as may be required and are consistent with the intent of the Grant Agreement, or to correct any scrivener's errors.
