ONGOING COUNCIL DECISIONS


\$70,200 of WW funds for two portables

- WW fund balance...capital program
- Ongoing lease, operations, and security
- Decision made in February

Potential \$26,438 WW funds for Portland Loo

- Total cost estimate \$355,000
- Potential Council decision on March 21

PORTABLES AND THE LOO



FUTURE COUNCIL DECISION

Longer term funding for the portables

\$70,000 annually

3 to 4 Portland Loos with WW funding

- **\$350,000** each
- **\$1,050,000 \$1,400,000 total**
- Plus operation at \$30,000 each/annually

UTILITY RATE IMPLICATIONS

Portables

- \$70,000 annually
 - **1.2% or \$0.42/month (+/-)**

Portland Loos

- \$350,000 + \$30,000 operation
 - 6.65% or \$2.53/month (+/-)
 - One-time? Reprioritize?

SIX-YEAR WW CAPITAL PROGRAM

Options for Reprioritizing


- Pipe repairs....\$390,000 annually
- Septic system conversions....\$340,000 annually
- Pump station rehab....\$620,000 annually



PILOT PROGRAM METRICS

- 1. <u>Utilization</u>: Measured in volume of material removed or using advanced tabulation methods (counters).
- 2. <u>Vandalism</u>: Receive reports from Honey Bucket as it pertains to our insurance policy. Visual checkups.
- 3. <u>Crime</u>: Receive reports as they relate to facilities from our partners at OPD. Help foster CPTED (Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design) friendly environment.
- 4. <u>Neighborhood Impacts</u>: Survey Fertile Grounds, Timberland Library and others within proximity.
- 5. <u>Costs</u>: Are the financial expenditures for the pilot in line with expectations?
