- 10. Provide a colors and materials board.
- 11. Provide details of window patterns and proportions (recessed or protruding).
- 12. Provide additional depth in building modulation along all facades (minimum of one (1) foot from wall plane).
- 13. Provide detailed black and white and colored renderings of the building elevations, the bicycle storage area, and the solid waste storage area, at the detail design review stage of consideration. Details should show dimensions of the framework (including bicycle structure choice), materials, and color choices.
