AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OLYMPIA, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE 2017 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING \$10,000 FROM THE PARKING BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT AREA (PBIA) FUND FOR MURALS

WHEREAS, there is a need for beautification of the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, there is sufficient fund balance in the PBIA fund to pay for the beautification of downtown; and

WHEREAS, the PBIA Board has approved \$10,000 for downtown beautification;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE OLYMPIA CITY COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following appropriations are hereby made:
