### GRuB School, Summer Camps & Field Trips





- GRuB offers a 7-week summer employment training program to youth who thrive when doing relevant work in our community
- GRuB partners with local school districts to enroll these students in a part-time, 3-credit academic year program
- Each spring, students in GRuB school participate in VGP garden builds, speak publicly at City Council meetings & host hundreds of younger kids at the GRuB farm for educational field trips

### **GRuB School Gets Results**

- GRuB has worked with nearly 450 high school youth with disproportionately high ACEs since we began this work in 1996
- Since we started the GRuB School model in 2011, here's our impact:
  - Only 39% of students have entered our program on-track to graduate; upon completion 88% have graduated or earned their GED and 66% moved on to college
  - The average science GPA of a GRuB School student increased from 1.20 to 2.69 - a 124% increase!!!
  - Our students also reported increased Locus of Control, effective leadership, communication skills, self-esteem & self-confidence
- "GRuB School impacted my communication, organization, and problem-solving skills in a positive way that my family, friends and community have noticed and appreciate." - Lilly, GRuB School student





# Youth Program Pollination & Expansion

- GRuB provides technical assistance & training to support other communities in launching GRuB-like youth development programs. We just hosted 14 educators from throughout the NW (and California!) for our annual GRuB Youth Development Institute!
- The first academic year of the Tumwater FRESH program is winding down as the second full growing season ramps up. FRESH is a partnership between the City of Tumwater, Tumwater School District & GRuB
- Tend, Gather & Grow wild food & medicine curriculum is underway



## **Community Food Solutions**





- GRuB's Kitchen Garden Project was founded in 1993 and since then has built nearly 3,000 free gardens in the South Sound
- GRuB offers low-cost community workshops to help people build skills to grow, prepare & preserve healthy food on a budget
- In 2015, GRuB launched the Victory Farmers program to engage transitioning veterans in community



## The Victory Garden Project

- In 2017, we will fold the Kitchen Garden Project & Victory Farmer programs together to honor the legacy of veteran leadership within these programs.
- This spring, we build ~ 50 "victory" gardens with low-income families, many of whom are single parent households; This year, 18 of these gardens are in Oly
- These gardens increase families' access to fresh produce, have positive health impacts, and are a joyful place for families to connect & grow together
- More than half of our VGP partners have children in the household, and nearly one third have elders in the household, too

## **GRuB's Victory Farm**

- In 2015, a team of veterans known as GRuB's Victory Farmers stewarded a ½ acre urban garden in East Olympia, where they grew more than 2,000 pounds of food that fed local veterans, hungry families & the neighborhood.
- We lost our lease on the farm in are currently raising funds to hire a veteran "Lead Victory Farmer" to lead the charge to launch a new farm. We are in conversation with the Thurston County Food Bank regarding a partnership in Lacey.
- Since 2014, more than 250 veterans have connected with GRuB in an integrated effort to prevent veteran suicide, support veteran integration & nourish our community!
- This year, we will distribute 10+ veterangrown CSA shares to veterans through partnerships with Drexel House & the Veteran Hub in Lacey. We host monthly peer support council sessions at the Veterans Hub.





## Cultivating Community & Leaders



- In 2014, we began taking some of the best pieces of our youth model & offering practical multi-cultural communication workshops to GRuB's partners, gardeners, veterans, youth families & more
- We've now hosted 9 trainings to more than 160 individuals, including 22 veterans



### **GRuB** in the Food Movement

- 2 acre urban farm with nature trail in West Olympia
- CSA share, market stand, and more
  - Low-income senior shares in partnership with Senior Services of South Sound
  - WIC parent shares
  - Youth shares for interns & GRuB School students
- South Sound Food System Network & Thurston Thrives
  - Local food culture campaign kicks off in June
  - South Sound Food Summit October 20 & 21 at SPSCC
