I own a 1922 Craftsman bungalow in the South Capital neighborhood. I am working with an architectural engineer to finish my attic in order to extend the space available in my home. In order to make that space more inviting and usable and to provide egress in the case of an emergency, I am requesting approval to **replace an existing vent** in the front of the home with a window, hand-built by Eco Woodworks to replicate the style and craftsmanship of the home's original windows.

A picture of the front of my home, illustrating the window installed as planned, is provided for your consideration. As you can see, the planned window will not destroy any historic materials, features or spatial relationships that characterize the property.
