

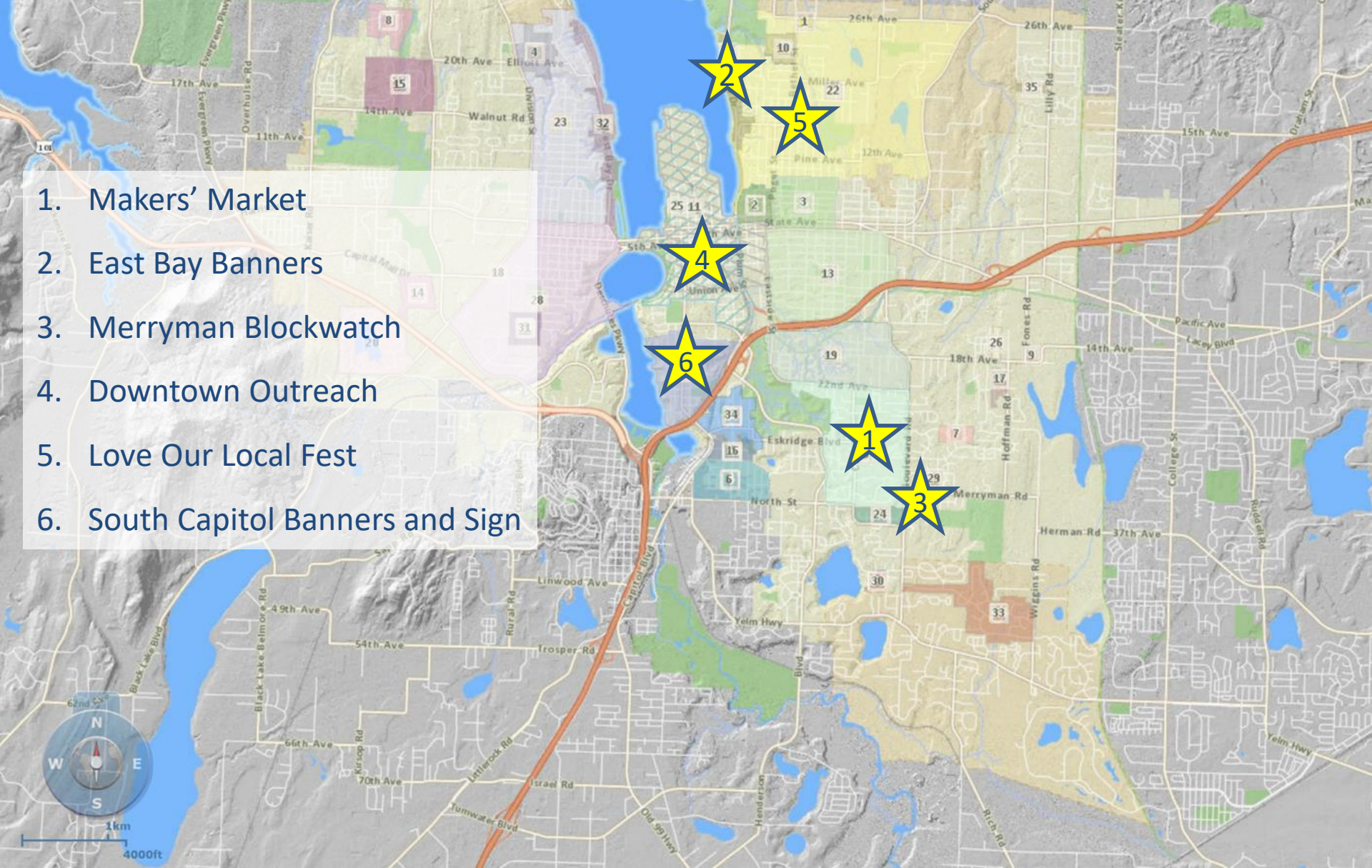

What makes an application eligible?

- Neighborhood recognition
- Project meets the program criteria
- Neighborhood can demonstrate at least a 50% match
- No open grants with the City
- Landowner permission
- Project complies with City contract requirements

Staff Recommendation
