# 2.5 UPDATE FROM FINANCIAL STAFF

Treasurer Debbie Sullivan reported on July 17, 2018 the Olympia City Council declared an emergency due to homelessness, established action items to address homelessness, and asked staff to come up with funding. She outlined a proposal to borrow from the non-voted utility tax (NVUT) for three years to address homelessness, and in return, extend the NVUT for parks acquisition until 2029.

Ms. Sullivan noted the Olympia Metropolitan Parks District (OMPD) Advisory Committee met October 24 and recommends extending the NVUT until 2030. She added staff's recommendation is to maintain the NVUT for parks acquisition until January 1, 2026 (which is the current agreement) and do an interfund loan for \$1,485,000 during the declared 3-year emergency.
