- 2. Add seating near the main entrance to the building. *OMC 18.110.050*.
- 3. Add the stormwater infiltration pond to the overall landscape plan. Ensure that the pond landscaping is integrated into the landscaping design. *OMC 18.110.170*.
- 4. Show planting details of the stormwater pond and the bioretention swale in the landscape plan, in section and plan view. Add additional sheets if necessary. *OMC 18.110.170*.
- 5. Provide plant photos of each plant in the Landscape Plan, Sheet L-1 or L-2. Reconsider the use of barberry adjacent to the sidewalk(s). *OMC 18.110.170*.
