**RE: Request for Payment of Necessary Expenses Pursuant to OMC Chapter 2.72 to
Judicially Determine the Sufficiency of Recall Charges Against Mayor Pro-Tem Nathaniel Jones**

Dear Councilmembers:

In accordance with OMC Chapter 2.72, I have determined from the wording of the “Demand for Recall and Discharge of Nathaniel Jones,” filed by Jon S. Pettit with the Thurston County Auditor on November 6, 2018, that a reasonable legal position can be established that the charges stated in the “Demand for Recall and Discharge” of Mayor Pro-Tem Jones are not sufficient for purposes of RCW 4.96.041.

I therefore approve the request from Mayor Pro-Tem Nathaniel Jones that the City of Olympia pay the necessary expenses in defending his in his official capacity as Mayor Pro-Tem of the City of Olympia in a judicial proceeding convened to determine the sufficiency of the charges set forth in the Demand for Recall and Discharge, subject to approval by the Olympia City Council in an open meeting.
